To Gundagai

Welcome to Wiradjuri land
Gawaymbanhadhu Wiradjuri-gu ngurambang-gu

Gundagai was a major thoroughfare and river crossing place. Clan groups of Wiradjuri people from the areas of Narrandera, Wagga Wagga and Cootamundra would join the locals for ceremony, trade and to gather food.

In November each year people would pass through Gundagai on the way to the high country east of Tumut to feast on great aggregations of Bogong moths and to participate in ceremony. The Murrumbidgee River provided a rich food source for our indigenous people and is culturally significant to the Wiradjuri people.

Today there are still many proud Wiradjuri people living in this area and caring for country as they have done for millennia.

Gundagai was first discovered by European explorers in the 1820s. Over the years the town has proved an irresistible subject for poets and songwriters such as Banjo Patterson. Many poems and stories were inspired by drovers, bullock teams and bush travellers in the Gundagai area.

The town is immortalised through poems and songs such as Where the Dog Sits on the Tuckerbox, Along the Road to Gundagai and is perhaps most famous for its monument to the early pioneers, the iconic Dog on the Tuckerbox, situated on the Hume Highway, 5 miles (8 km) north of Gundagai.

RUSCONI'S MARBLE MASTERPIECE

A true craftsman, Frank Rusconi built this impressive display from 20,948 individual pieces of marble, every piece cut, turned and polished by hand over a 28 year period. Incredibly, no plans or drawings have ever been found and it appears he did the statue entirely by sight alone. The sculpture can be viewed daily.

GABRIEL GALLERY

THE GREAT RESCUE OF 1852 SCUPLTURE

This larger than life-size, bronze sculpture was erected to commemorate the 165th anniversary of the Great Flood of Gundagai in 1852. The sculpture celebrates the heroic work of Yarri and Jacky Jacky, along with other members of the Wiradjuri tribe in saving some 69 townsfolk from the floodwaters.

DOG

on the Tuckerbox

The story of The Dog captured the imagination of all Australians through the poem Bullocky Bill by Jack Moses, adapted from an earlier version by otherwise unknown author Bowyang Yorke, in the early 1900s. The legend was then immortalised in popular song by Jack O'Hagan - "Where the Dog Sits on the Tuckerbox".

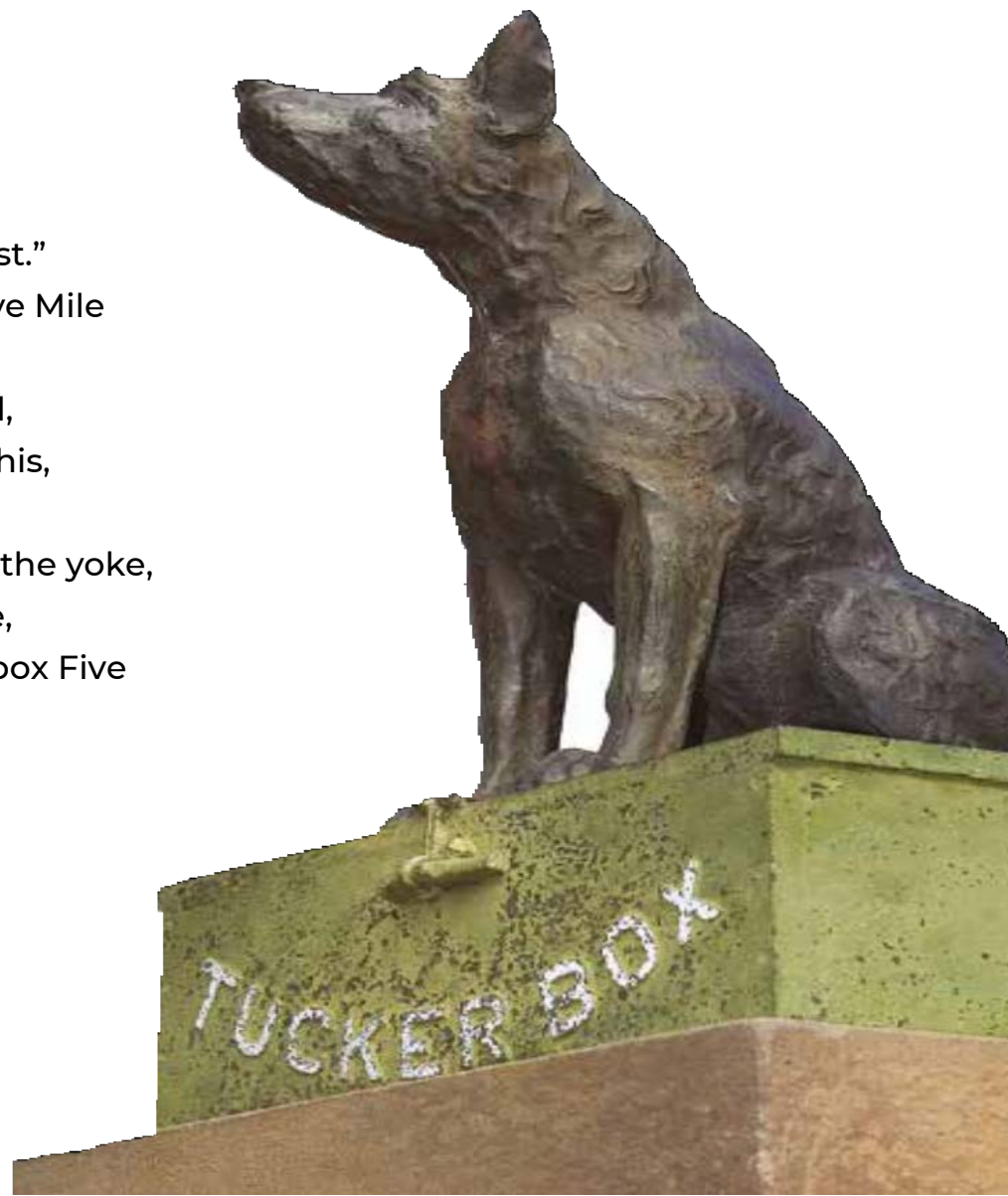
An internationally recognised Australian icon, The Dog on the Tuckerbox monument was created in 1932 by Frank Rusconi as a tribute to our early pioneer settlers.

The Dog is situated 8kms (or 5 miles) north of Gundagai, just off the Hume Highway.

As I was coming down Conroy's Gap
I heard a maiden cry,
"There goes Bill the bullocky,
He's bound for Gundagai.
A better poor old bastard

OUTDOOR *Activities*

Gundagai offers some excellent outdoor recreation facilities, including the Olympic pool with well maintained grounds and shady trees to relax under with a netball and basketball complex located across the road.

The Gundagai District Services Club also have some fantastic facilities including golf course, bowling greens, tennis & squash courts. Gundagai also hosts some awesome parks with great playgrounds such as Carberry Parks Adventure Playground. Both Carberry Park and Yarri Park offer free BBQ's and shaded sitting areas.

Gundagai also has an amazing pump track and skate park located at Yarri Park with quality sports fields located across the road at Anzac Park.



CYCLING & WALKING TRAILS

Connect with nature on two feet, or jump on your bike and find new adventures. You can do both right here in Gundagai. Our town is connected by waterways and trails that will guide you on your way. Whether its enjoying our 4km Dog on the Tuckerbox Trail that connects the town with our beloved icon or a leisurely stroll across our flood plain under our beloved historic bridges on our River Walk. We have something for everyone.



KAYAKING & CANOEING

There are many great spots in Gundagai to kayak or canoe! Teach the kids in the quiet, slow waters of Morley's Creek or for the more advanced rower take in a stretch of the fast flowing Murrumbidgee River.

FISHING

With the Murrumbidgee River at Gundagai's back door, the temptation to the angling enthusiasts and amateurs cannot be resisted. Common species found in the river are brown and rainbow trout, murray cod and yellow-belly. Spend a peaceful weekend relaxing on the banks of the Murrumbidgee or Morley's Creek. A boat ramp is located on the Murrumbidgee River 3kms to the east of Gundagai along the Nangus Road otherwise Stoney's Beach is easy to access allowing riverside fishing.

FESTIVALS & Events



SUMMER

Summer is Gundagai's biggest season for local events. In December we hold our annual Christmas Carols in the Park along with many local stalls. On the 1st of January the Gundagai- Adelong Racing Club hold their New Years Day Races attracting many locals visitors. During the middle of February the town comes together to celebrate our annual Gundagai Show. Our town celebrates every Australia Day with a presentation of awards to deserving local community members.



AUTUMN

Another fantastic horse racing event is the Gundagai Cup attracting large crowds willing to put on a bet! Every ANZAC Day the community comes together to commemorate with a dawn service at ANZAC Grove followed by a main street march lead by the Gundagai's 7th Light Horse Troop.

WINTER

Each year in July we commemorate the anniversary of the Great Flood of 1852. The monthly Sundry in Gundy Markets also continue on the last Sunday of every month between the hours of 9pm to 1pm. We are also a great place to base yourselves if you are travelling to surrounding towns such as Cootamundra, Tumut, Batlow, Junee or Tumbarumba.



SPRING

Gundagai is buzzing during the beautiful Spring months. During October, Gundagai host's one of the leading Stockman's Challenges in Australia showcasing local horsemanship. Gundagai also celebrates all things floral with its annual Flower Show. November is our busiest month of the year with our famous Snake Gully Cup attracting thousands of attendees each year ready to get frocked or suited up to enjoy a lovely day of racing. The Gundagai Rodeo is a premier event on the national rodeo circuit. As the final event on the ABCRA calendar, competition is fierce as the nation's top cowboys and cowgirls battle for a coveted national title.

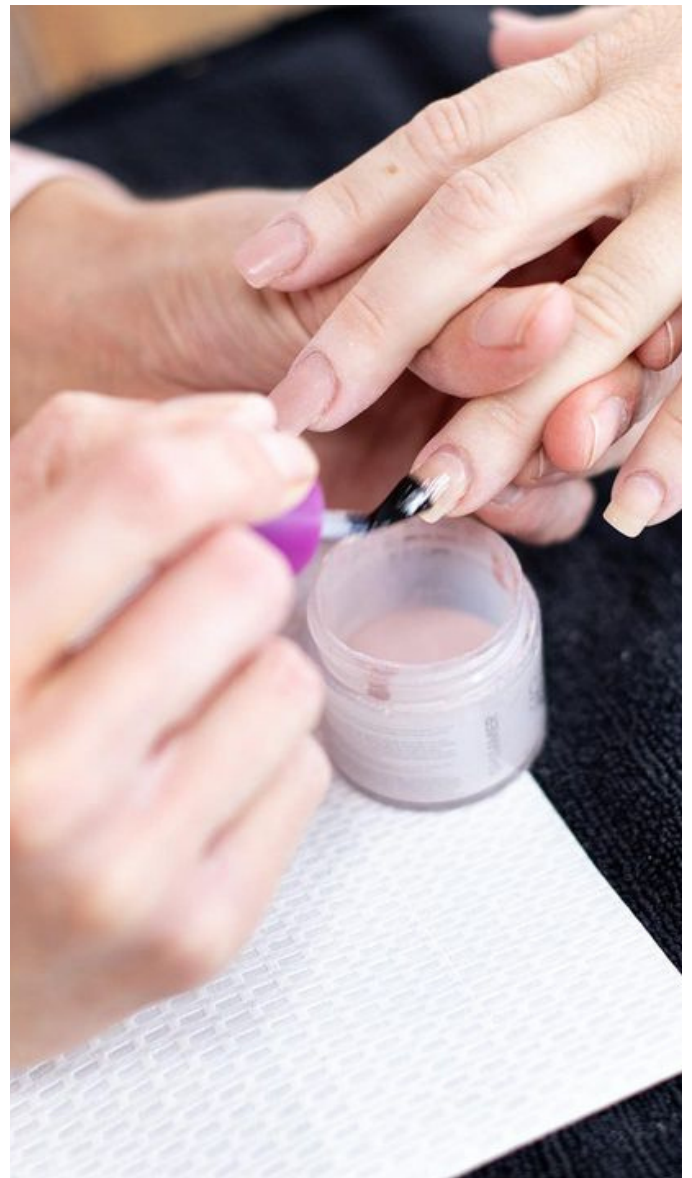




